Museum Interpreters, in tandem with MOV Visitor Experience staff, provide the first point of contact with MOV visitors. Knowledgeable and engaging, they play a vital part in ensuring a rewarding visitor experience.

### **Duties include:**

- Greet and orient visitors entering A Seat at the Table (SAT) gallery space
- Provide information about the SAT project and SAT partners and upcoming public programs
- Facilitate learning experience of museum visitors by interacting with them and demonstrating use of interactive exhibition components
- Support and conduct visitor studies
- Support Visitor Experience personnel in keeping the MOV galleries a safe environment by following safety protocols and assisting with light cleaning and replenishing of supplies
- Liaise with Visitor Experience, Learning and Curatorial staff

### **Youth Eligibility Requirements and Qualifications:**

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment
- Have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations
- Must enjoy working with the public and able to communicate effectively with broad range of public, including children and adults
- Must be reliable and punctual
- Strong verbal and written communication skills in English and in Cantonese and/or Mandarin
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to build positive working relationships with MOV staff
- High School diploma, with additional museum or gallery training, hospitality, tourism or related subject training or equivalent training and experience

**Hours:** Total hours are flexible, and may range from 21-35 per week, depending on availability. Shifts are usually during daytime hours, taking place Wednesday to Sunday.
