19th Annual LEGO® Brick Exhibit***

Sidney, British Columbia, November 22, 2024 - The Sidney Museum is excited to announce the Community Creations display, a new feature in the upcoming 19th Annual LEGO® Brick Exhibit. Members of the public are now invited to submit their own LEGO® Brick creations to be displayed at the museum.

The Community Creations display will feature 48 unique builds over the course of the exhibit. These creations will be done by community members who can submit their ideas to the Sidney Museum for review. If selected, they will be displayed at the Sidney Museum for one month, either January, February, or March 2025.

Submissions must be smaller than 10" Wide x 10" Long x 10" High, made entirely of LEGO® bricks, and be original designs in order to be selected for display.

"Getting the community involved in its annual LEGO® brick exhibit is always a goal of the Sidney Museum," says Michael Goodchild, Executive Director. "Whether playing with LEGO® bricks and building sets is a lifelong passion or a newfound hobby, this collaborative display has a place for everyone."
