2001.044.007	basket, fruit		Small fruit or berry basket composed of 2 thin wood veneer pieces bent to form basket and held in place using a thin green metal frame around the top edge. Words inscribed or burned into the bottom, "FRUIT REMAINS GOOD - SHIPPED IN WOOD".
2001.044.008	basket, fruit		Small fruit or berry basket composed of 2 thin wood veneer pieces bent to form basket and held in place using a thin green metal frame around the top edge. Words inscribed or burned into the bottom, "FRUIT REMAINS GOOD - SHIPPED IN WOOD".
2005.044.001	Snowshoe		Pr. of snowshoes, wood frame, pointed at both ends, longest point to the back, webbed with leather strips, the fittings for the feet have been added later, not part of the original design.
2006.035.009	Show shoes		Pr. Snowshoes, bent cedar wood w/ rawhide and cord lacing, wide leather strap for holding foot, long tail.
2007.005.002	Bicycle		Young boys bicycle, red w/ black seat, has a cross-bar and chain guard, balloon tires. Has a label from 'Vernon Lock & Cycle', circa 1960s.
2007.118.003	Suitcase		Cardboard suitcase with brown and white finish that resembles tweed fabric. Re-enforced metal corners and trim, bakelite handle, metal clasps. Stencil on top "Custom Tailors" - "Hong Kong". Label "Holland America Line C.H. Troyer --" dated 1968

2008.075.012	Sign, Advertising		Large enamel advertising on a metal sheet, "Ellison Flour - Milled from Selected Canadian Wheat", in white red and blue.
2008.085.001	Record cabinet		Cabinet model, stereo, wood (mahogany) with speakers at each end. Hinged top lifts to give access to radio and turntable for records. Label inside "The Canadiana created and crafted for Canadas Centennial 1867 - 1967" Built by Bob Simpson. Made by Eaton's company.
2011.002.006	Board, advertising		Free standing advertising board for "Harvey Woods" socks. All of plywood sections showing a foot with pantleg, cuff and shoe. The leg portion folds out and holds a sock as a sample. "Harvey Woods Multi-ply Reinforced Toe & Heel"
2011.060.006	Washboard		Wood frame washboard with textured glass insert. "ECONOMY GLASS"
2012.020.001	Chair		Chair made from a wooden barrel, cut away to form a back and the seat is hinged at the front for storage in the bottom half.
2013.012.003	Tray, serving	 2013.012.003	Wicker Curate's Assistant. Four tiers starting with largest at the bottom and decreases in size at each tier. The three legs are wrapped in wicker and each tier is a round plate shape woven in a pattern. The three legs come together at the top and form a loop.
2014.009.001	Snowshoe		Pair snowshoes, Huron style, tear-drop shape with a long tail. Wood frame, (White Ash?) with rawhide webbing and leather strapping. Two wood re-enforcing bars.

2018.004.003	Chair, Hockey		Goal judge chair. Black leather "L" shaped cushioned seat on a tall, unfinished wood "A" frame stand. There is a foot rest on the front of the stand.
