










1969.037.003	Sprayer, Hand		<p>Agriculture, insect & diseases, spraying, hand tool, pressure, tank. Cylindrical insecticide container with a plunger handle at the top, ovular with two openings. There is a steel handle at the back. The body of the container is brass, made by Winnipeg Brass Limited, whose name is engraved on the side of the neck. There is a curved red spout on the shoulder for attaching a hose or nozzle; there is also a round dial for accessing the filling hole. A decal on the body of the container reads "[...]LL[...]D BY C.C. SNOWDON[...]EFLER & IMPORTER SANISPRAY ON[...]TO B(?)[...]USED[...]ING[...]HROIL[...]ARE[...]URN(?)[...]CALGARY[...]OF[...]EDMONTON[...]SLK[...]VER." (very worn, difficult to read). The base is painted red. Previous cataloguer noted that the cylindrical neck probably extends to near the bottom of the tank as the handle extends further down.</p>	<p>Fair - Very tarnished body. Decal very worn. Some rust at the top.</p>
1978.153.001	Bag, Harvesting		<p>Standard fruit-picking bag or can composed of a galvanized tin body with a canvas bag underneath and felt-lined canvas strap above. The body is a half-circle and has faint stamped lettering on the front. The canvas bag has metal rings near the bottom with a rope fed through for cinching the base shut; the rope is held in place by a metal clamp on the metal body. The felt lining on the strap is black or dark purple. Writing in black marker reads THE POTHECARY on the outside of the strap, and J.A. on the inside; black writing on the bag reads "270". Heavy rings on can for holding straps.</p>	<p>Fair - Felt straps worn. Makers name nearly worn off. Canvas soiled. Some tarnish or rust on rope hook/clamp. Some staining on interior of strap and minor fraying of fabric throughout.</p>
2025.001.319	Basket, Fruit Picking		<p>Fruit-picking basket with a tin basket and a canvas bag. The bottom of the bag features a metal loops for a drawstring which would allow the bag to be emptied with ease. The semi-circular basket has a canvas strap attached to it, which is padded at regular intervals with black wool. There are hooks on the sides of the basket.</p>	<p>Poor - Nails rusting on strap and staining canvas. Scratches and general wear. Brown stains on vancas bag. Some fraying at ends. Some holes. Rusting of hooks on sides. Tarnish on lip. Drawstring missing.</p>

1964.020.002	Bell, sleigh		Bells, sleigh. 1 set. Leather with four bells attached: two large in the centre and two smaller at the ends.	Fair
1970.043.013	Safe		Small steel floor safe, black with gold borders on the door and green borders around the top and sides. The dial is bronze, and the handle is composed of a tarnished silver frame. There are four wheels. NOTE: While the safe pictured is most likely the safe associated with this number, it is difficult to confirm as no number was found on the safe itself.	Fair - Dented on top. Scratches throughout, especially on sides and top. General wear.
1971.081.010	warmer, foot		Metal footwarmer, perforated at ends, wrapped with carpeting, in the shape of an oval cylinder with 2 handles. On one end is a knob for pulling out the heater cartridge (likely held hot coals or a heated brick) . On the other end, there is embossed lettering reading THE CLARK HEATER. Natural and yellow (?) in colour. Model name: The Clark Heater Carpeting missing as of Aug 2025. Most likely the one that was formerly on display in the Minty Coach (pictured above).	Poor - Carpeting missing as of Aug 2025. Very rusted on ends. Some white corrosion. Spots of black tarnish. Cartridge cannot be opened.
1987.001.037	Spike, Rail		Rail spike, rust colour.	Very corroded
1998.089.002	Suitcase		Brown metal suitcase lined with wood, 2 metal clip fasteners on front and centre lockable metal clasp. 'T.W.Cowan' stencilled in white on the lid.	Fair - battered throughout, handle repaired with black electricians tape.
2000.047.048	Bells, sleigh		Length of strap with bells riveted on. The ends narrow down and have a buckle on one end and perforations on the others. 224cm(l) x 2.5cm(w)	Fair - Bells are tarnished and the leather is cracking.

2002.012.002	Bells, Harness		Set of 6 brass horse harness bells, held together with leather strapping & buckles. No makers name or mark.	Fair - One bell chipped, all very tarnished, leather badly cracked.
2009.083.001	Transit		Surveyors transit housed in a mahogany box with a hinged door. Model No. 5525056 and dated 1955, 'Handy 2 inch Transit' Adjustable wooden tripod with fittings for transit and has sharp metal tips on the legs. Wooden case has leather strap for carrying.	Good - case and tripod show signs of wear
2009.107.001	Basket, egg		Yellow, plastic coated wire basket with wire handle. Round, straight sloping sides.	Fair - signs of wear, plastic coating has worn away.
2025.001.314	Press, Book		Black-painted cast-iron book press. There is a wheel in the centre of two curved arms, both of which extend up from the platform of the press. The top of the press slants up slightly at each side, creating a somewhat conical shape. There is golden lettering on one side, which reads "STANDARD" in cursive. A maker's mark also reads "[...] Toronto Canada", though the majority of it can no longer be read. There is a "4" embossed on one of the arms.	Poor - Maker's mark very chipped/worn. Worn overall with silver metal showing. Rusted/tarnished throughout. Extensive corrosion and grime, especially underneath.
2026.001.049	Window		9 panel stained glass window, with wooden framing. Glass is translucent and light yellow in colour, held between grey metal (lead) strips. Window has circular motifs at the edge of each pane.	Good - Shows signs of wear along wood, and there is a small crack (~1in) in the glass of the centre pane.
