Board is fragile and is warped due to improper size of bin -- weight of object is pulling one corner down, warping the wood upwards and rendering the wood there stressed and a little fragmentary

One of the interpreters at SNL figured the ones visible on exhibit in that building are for a rope ladder; one can also see one of these pins set upright in the SNL where it is used for tying off rope at the knot tying station - so perhaps multipurpose. All items are in good condition.

Onto this box is fixed a light green coloured metal tube with a button and twisted cable terminating in a GE plug. Box seems at one time to have had a lid as one side (one of the two with hooks) there are two holes that appear to be made by screws -- inscription is on this side; opposite there is a singular hole but not nearly as deep (a few millimetres); hooks have made circular marks on wood from being rotated.
