B4 1	Pile of mixed wood, two small boxes of rusty metal fittings - not artefacts		Small pile of long pieces of wood perhaps three main components: (1) appears to be a trestle sort of construction, two long planks one of which is rectangular with one side slightly rounded, painted a semi-glossy light gray, (2) rectangular piece of wood, unfinished. (3) additional two small cut pieces of wood, one of which is painted a matte light gray. Also present are two small wooden boxes of rusty metal fittings, mainly bolts, washer, nuts, screws: potentially related to building roof work in recent past
C3 1	Gas cookstove	1	Gas (propane?) cookstove/range, made of metal, painted white and black, standing on four legs. Cookstove is comprised of 3 sections: lower, middle, and upper. Lower section consists of a black shelf attached to the legs, same width as cookstove. Middle section consists of a white shelf above which is ran a metal tube with a white knob at object's proper left side and a large circular metal drum/pan at proper right; connected to this tube are three burners, each with its own white knob (6-segments with a circle in the middle). Upper section consists of black cover with three holes corresponding to the three burners, each with a grill originally though only left and middle grills are extant. Rust patches on all surfaces.
C4 1	Pallet of light shades and lantern shrouds	11	7 green light shades, 3 light blue lantern shrouds, 1 light chimney with grey painted metal lid.
C4 2	Coil of black rubber tubing	1	Length of black rubber tubing, coiled. Paper tag attached from McLennan, McFeely & Prior Limited, noting on backside to not accept goods until examined.
D1 1	Pile of oars	7	Pile of oars of differing diametres and cuts, 7 in total; painted various colours. No two appear paired. Typically, blades are long and thin, with width no larger than width of shaft generally. Oars of note are as follows. 1x with remnants of light blue paint, shaft necked down to smaller diametre at grip end. 1x dark brown/varnished finish with black leather (?) wrap around portion of shaft. 1x white painted, shaft necked down to smaller diametre towards grip end, handle being rectangular in shape with a blade with rounded tip.
D1 2	Pile of oars	19	Pile of oars of differing cuts and colours of paint, 19 in total. Many appear paired. Oars of note are as follows. 2x with 2/3rds length of shaft painted red, rest in white. 1x yellow painted with triangular grip. 1x light blue painted. 1x dark blue painted with necked down shaft at grip. 3x white painted, one with canvas protective wrapping at portion of shaft; two oars are different, but medium gauge, diametres, both with necked down shafts at grip end; one blade is long, one is short. 2x silver/grayish white painted. 1x unpainted, mostly varnished, with varnish extending halfway up shaft; carved on one side of shaft is "[B]Britannia Heritage Site". 1x oar with yellow BHSS card tied to it with green string: donor's name is given as "Canadian Pacific Company" dated May 1994, with description being "dark paint paddle" (?).
D1 3	Gaff hook	1	Gaff hook comprised of wooden handle and metal rounded spike which is attached to handle by long length of dirty, thin, grayish white twine which hafts spike to handle. Wood is split in few places, particularly at butt end and spike end. Butt end of handle is broken as well.
D2 2	Oars	2	Two identical wooden oars, painted white, with rectangular blades tapering at rear to thick shaft, the final 13cm of which is necked down to smaller diametre; traces of red paint transfer present across length of shaft.
D3 1	Pallet of ropes	3?	Approximately 3 coils of thick rope of two kinds: a thick light tan rope, tightly woven/braided; and a dark khaki brown-coloured twisted rope.
D3 2	Pallet of part moulds	100	4 boxes of various small wooden casting moulds of various circular and linear shapes. One box (amalgamated with another as bottom gave way) was labeled "valves discs". Objects represented appear to be nuts, hub plates/valve discs, engine/motor parts, piston/pipe parts, rollers, struts/clamps, and wheels (rollers, etc.). Almost all painted: blacks (majority), reds, yellows attested. Some objects labeled "W&G".
D3 3	Pallet of part moulds	100	4 boxes of various small wooden casting moulds of primarily cylindrical and linear shapes, some discs/wheels. Items represented appear to be toe carol components, screws(?), small spools/reels, large struts, grills/vents, wheels/rollers, rods, struts. All painted: black attested

D4 1	Pallet of part moulds	25	Pallet of large size Webb and Gifford casting moulds, all wood; rounded and linear shapes present. Types represented appear to be large diameter piping or transmission components, bearings and rings, a ratchet, three rollers of small sizes, and uncertain rectangular/linear objects. Colours present: mainly black, some yellow, some red. Presence of writing on some with yellow grease pencil; in blue grease pencil on one anchor-shaped piece reads in cursive "Rub [illegible] off mold". One item labeled "W&G", another "Webb and Gifford". One item with long description reading "CORE BOX / STEP BEARING(?) AND SHEEVE HOUSING / ESPINOSA AND KOPRING(?)".
E3 3	Pallet of part moulds	50	Pallet of Burrard Dry Dock casting moulds, all of wood; two boxes contain pulley, roller, and piping parts mainly it seems: one match plate mould present, painted in red, of some sort of cap/base plate with "M.E.I." written on along edge; shop pipe bender and unloader finger moulds present. On rest of pallet are moulds for a silver cap with two pipe connections (?), a rounded and ribbed piece, a mount, a transmission body piece (?), and a rocker arm mould. A few are marked "B.D.D." or "Burrard Dry Dock." Mostly painted black but red, yellow, and silver present.
E3 4	Pallet of engine moulds	75	Pallet of Webb and Gifford casting moulds, all of wood; three boxes on pallet, other items piled on; generally rounded or complex shapes present. Types represented appear to be piping components, rounded mounts/brackets, rollers, housing components, pins/linear mounts, propellor components (?), a board with very many holes through (reminiscent to me of a stair with drainage holes), pieces with fins, struts, and other linear shapes; a large engine housing (?) mould is present, profile is like a lightbulb's, featuring three pipes in a triangular formation within a raised circular area, with a squarish pipe below and a large squarish linear piece extending from top. One item is labeled "PS (?) DOVE". Mostly painted black but red and yellow present, some non-painted present as well. Some items labeled "W&G" or "Webb and Gifford".
E3 5	Group of 4 objects	4	Group of four objects: a metal roller wheel; a wooden adjustable table mount (?); a metal line-shaft hanger with central clamp broken/disjointed; and a mountable metal jack (?) painted red with a black handle featuring a free-moving metal rod. The table mount and roller wheel appear sodden wet, as can be seen in water marks on ground in photograph.
E3 6	Pallet of part moulds and FLG bushing	25	Pallet of Burrard Dry Dock ring-shaped casting moulds with one box of smaller moulds, all of wood. Objects present are generally rings, or flat pieces, few elongated oval shapes. Named items are: ring for Weyerhaeuser Bauer feeder; a propeller patch; boring mill nuts; and a 40 3/16"x2 1/4" ring. Box contains various types of nuts (hexagonal), handles, roller wheels, cupped pieces, and bearings. Large wooden FLG Bushing A3000 also present. Some marked "B.D.D.". All painted: blacks, reds, and yellows present.
E4 1	Pallet of engine moulds	2	Two large engine (?) casting moulds and loose associated pieces, made of dark brown wood at one time painted red; paint either sprayed on weakly or has been much worn down through weathering as wood grain can be seen in many places through a reddish tint. Moulds appear to be for engine housing, both generally rectangular in shape with 6 semi-cylindrical pieces jutting from sides (3 each side), and 4 mounts (?) on one side with tank like piece opposite. Appears to be top and bottom for same housing. Mounts are stamped "1 41" and on few spots of housing itself is stamped "1141" - uncertain significance.
E4 2	Pallet of casting mould	7	Group of 5 casting moulds of rings of varying large diameter, one squarish frame, one rocker arm (?), all of wood, and one T-shaped metal brace/mount. Four of the ring moulds are constructed of smaller pieces of wood glued together in pattern similar to a "running" pattern on a brick wall; one is constructed similarly to a "Flemish" pattern for a brick wall; four rings are painted black, one seems to be red overpainted with silver. Frame appears to be something for an engine, perhaps something to encase it from above (?); the frame is painted red and black. Rocker arm has in its center a protruding cylindrical piece with a smaller cylinder extending from its center (perhaps a pipe); the arm is painted black. Metal mount is in T-shape, comprised of two square shaped pipes welded together perpendicularly, out of the vertical "stem" of the T extends two small arms, presumably for fixing in place or mounting something; 3 small holes in lower portion of mount. One item labeled "BURRARD DRY DOCK", another "YARROWS".
E4 3	Pallet of part moulds	25	Pallet of Webb and Gifford casting moulds, all of wood; generally circular, rounded, and complex shapes present. Types represented appear to be rollers/wheels, mounts, engine body components (?), brackets, arrow-shaped pieces, arms, piping/tubing, and bearings/rings. Almost all objects painted black, few unpainted. One item labeled "W&G".H43

F1 1	3 generator related components	3	Three objects present: (1) filter for generator: circular in shape with square box set to one side; a rope is coiled through and around various parts of the generator filter, yellow coiled rope. Out of the front of the filter is a small too grooved roller; on box is tag that reads "FILTER FOR GENERATOR / 75 AMPS. REF. R.C.A.F. [above this is arrow head pointing upwards] 5U/151 / MADE BY ROGERS MAJESTIC LTD. / SERIAL NO. 2698". (2) potentially second filter - similar in shape to #1, on side is set of large, two-grooved roller with three spokes; blue rope wrapped around coil; insulated wires hanging from one side. (3) linear object, featuring tubular shaft mounted in rectangular box with plate on one side with hole same size as shaft diameter; tube has drum with label reading "MORSE MCHAIINE / DIVISION / BORG WARNER"; blue rope is wound around the tube
F1 3	Wooden lever handle	1	Large wooden lever handle, mostly cylindrical with last 10cm necked down to smaller diameter; bottom end (where it might be inserted into something), is rectangular, possessing a shoulder cut into the body about 4.5cm around halfway down. Rectangular end is 9x9cm.
F2 4	Engine component?	1	White painted metal component, perhaps for engine or related marine-use. 3-tiered object with circular body, on one side (top most tier) of body is squarish component out of which run on one side two pipes with threaded ends, and, on opposite end, two threaded connections. Squarish box has text "PORT-1" and "PORT-2" on either side; metal manufacturer's label, containing name "OILGEAR" in two gears side by side, with "U.S. PATENT / 2074068 / PATENTS PEND" below which is serial number "X-174528" (? serial is difficult to read). On other side of circular body is greased/oiled 2-tiered circular component with metal rod projecting out with hole in centre. Pipe extends out bottom of object. Sodden paper tag attached to one of the pipes of squarish box: "FROM / THE OILGEAR COMPANY / MILWAUKEE WIS. U.S.A. / 1 PC. / OILGEAR NO. 1 - 4477(?) / ORD. NO. 0-92259(?) / MOTOR CONSTANT / DISPLACEMENT
F3 4	Crate of part moulds	25	Crate of Burrard Dry Dock casting moulds, mostly match plate patterns, all of wood; some labeled "Burrard Yarrows" or "B.D.D.". Types present are a pintle bushing, "provincial ferry locking plate", plug sockets, dock plate, bearing/ring, two types of grills (or perhaps staircase steps?), and other uncertain pieces (one partially broken). Metal Victaulic pipe L-/corner piece present too, painted red. Most painted yellow, but black and red pieces present. Bottom of crate has lots of organic material (twigs/blades of grass/reed etc.). Crate itself is painted silver
F3 6	Pallet of parts moulds and objects piled to its left	25	Pallet of Burrard Dry Dock casting moulds, all of wood, and one yellow plastic spatula and one small red and clear plastic light fixture (?). Generally cylindrical shapes present, two match plate pattern present. Some objects labelled "B.D.D." or "Burrard". Types represented appear to be various kinds of nuts, spools, pipe/cylinder components, large washers, and seals; some named items are: deck scupper body, column nut, pintle nut, loft 1/2 gear A, "1 off seal", 10" hot top, and deck pads for stanchions. All painted: mostly black; red, yellow, and silver present too. Some coiled white rope present too, attached to crate which holds a number of moulds. One box has written on its side "2-off CORE / B.D.D." in yellow, and, below (and partially overwritten by previous text), "MARINE WAYS". Red light fixture I believe is not related to BDD, see research notes.
F4 1	Pallet of part moulds	25	Pallet of large casting moulds, all of wood; complex shapes present. Types represented appear all to be engine housing components, large diameter piping, frames/casings, rollers, or large mounts. Manufacturer marks in raised characters on one object Webb & Gifford Ltd New Westminster BC". Most objects retain original wood finish, only certain pieces on mould picked out in black. One yellow mould present.
F4 2	Pallet of part moulds	10	Pallet of casting moulds, all of wood; complex shapes present. Manufacturer marks in raised characters on many of the components, variously reading: "W & G", "Webb & Gifford". Most objects retain original wood finish, only certain areas on mould picked out in black.
F4 3	Pallet of part moulds	2	Pallet of casting moulds, all of wood; complex shapes present. Various manufacturer marks for Webb & Gifford. Objects retain original wood finish, only certain areas on moulds picked out in black.
G1 1	Partial remains of wooden boat	1	Half-section of boat and three long wooden pieces pertaining to missing side; once complete but past attempted restoration work damaged boat significantly extant. White BHSS artifact tag tied to one loose boat piece reads "B-005". Traces perhaps of greenish blue paint on internal face of boat. At bow portside interior is text reading "NO. 9". Exterior of ship is painted golden yellow colour, paint flaking off; external port side face of boat towards bow has section of white paint streaks.
G2 4	Cardboard boxes and plastic bags of fishing floats	100	2x large cardboard boxes containing football shaped styrofoam floats with internal rims painted blue, orange, or gray. 2x semi-transparent plastic bags, one containing circular cork floats strung together with green string; also in bag are more modern football-shaped floats. Second bag contains wooden football-shaped floats strung together with green string alongside a cardboard box containing a variety of floats of different colours, shapes, and materials (football and circular shapes: colours present are yellow, brown, orange, and cream).

G3 2	Triangular wooden moulds(?) / support bases(?)	2	Two large, identical, triangular dark brown wooden frames, presumably either casting moulds or the base of some type of support. Tied together with blue cord, the two frames are painted black on outside face only, inside is unpainted; two roughly triangular projections from frame edge and round projection at bottom left of frame (reference photo) remain unpainted as well. Interior of frame on outside frame is one continuous, asymmetrically groove which does not connect at top. Two points of triangle are raised, roughly rounded triangular areas; one point is raised circular area. Uncertain purpose.
G3 3	Two match plate pattern moulds	2	Two wooden match plate pattern moulds from the Burrard Dry Dock company, one plate painted primarily silver, the other primarily black. The silver plate pattern is rectangular in shape with corners cut at 45 degrees; at each end is a rectangular cut with holes either side for screws/fasteners, with one end featuring a rusted metal mount fastened to the plate, with text that reads "GENERAL FOUNDRY SERVICE CORP". Forming a rectangular border around the mould proper are raised and depressed teeth-like features, presumably for lining up each side in the sand for casting as one side's depression corresponds to a raised tooth on the other; mould is for presumably a transmission pipe component: two thick cylinders, painted black, appear parallel on the plate, connected on one side at either end by an unpainted mass of wood abutting a yellow-painted pipe that extends out of each side of the cylinders; on the cylinders appears writing reading "100 OFF" and "B.D.D."; on one side "CAST STEEL" is written in yellow on one black cylinder. The other, black plate is rectangular in shape, with rectangular cuts with rounded ends at each side of the plate: into the sides of both cuts are driven nails in an X pattern, and some distance away appear a hole either side of the cut, towards the edges of the plate, for mounting/fastening; mould proper features 4 parts attached by arms radiating from central mass; mould presumably is for various pipe fittings/connections, featuring one four-way pipe connection, with both yellow and black colours present; on one side of plate are written various things in yellow, green, and white, some crossed out or otherwise illegible: "D.D." is written in green, 'STOCK / 2" LOW' in white.
G3 4	Pallet of part moulds	25	Pallet of casting moulds, all of wood; complex shapes present. Types represented appear all to be piping, bases/mounts, rings/bearings, and winches. Some marked "Burrard Dry Dock." Some labeled objects include: "Scupper valve / bell mouth", "B143 HULL 344 TANKER 2 OFF SEAL RING", and "BURRARD # 505 / 1 OFF O.S.(?)". Colours present: mostly black, some yellow; some green present but only coating inside of groove on one piece.
G4 1	Crate of part moulds	25	Crate of large casting moulds, all of wood; linear and circular shapes present. Types represented appear all to be piping related or circular shapes; one large wheel with singular central strut, rectangular in shape with bolts and nuts on each side present - diameter of wheel is approximately 70cm; one large quarter section of a drum (? long, cylindrical piece); one many-grooved object in appearance similar to a grill/vent cover. One large silver panel, uncertain identification, present at bottom buried under mass of moulds. Colours present: mostly black, one white/silver, few green. Some items marked "CFC"/".CF. Co", others painted green in CFC's typical colour. One item has written on side "WADENA".
G4 2	Pallet of part moulds	25	Pallet of large casting moulds, all of wood; complex and circular shapes present. Types represented appear all to be piping, bearings/rings, wheels/roller, transmission housing components (?). Some marked "BDD". Two pieces marked "1 core" and "6 full core" respectively. Some labeled objects include: "CONE BOX - / PISTON - 15 HP / TYPE Y C. O.", "PISTON PATTERN / FOR / FAIRBANKS MORSL OIL ENGINE", and BEARING SIG FOR 80 P. PELLER". Colours present: mostly black, some red, portions marked out in yellow. One item labeled "B.D.D."
G4 3	Pallet of part moulds	25	Pallet of large casting moulds, all of wood; generally circular shapes present. Types represented appear to be bearings/rings and wheels/rollers. Some marked "B. D. D." One box marked "Burrard Yarrows clutch drum" with white spray-painted S over top "Yarrows". One object labeled "Bevel gear blank // 25 3/4 dia // 5 1/4 face(?). Colours present: mostly yellow, some black, some red.
G4 4	Pallet of parts moulds	25	Pallet of large casting moulds, all of wood; complex and rectangular shapes present. Types represented appear all to be transmission housing components (?), rollers/wheels, and one blade. Some marked "BDD"/"Burrard Yarrows". One match plate pattern present for two rollers. One blade mould labeled "blade #4". One match plate pattern labeled with metal tag "B D D RH / 864 / 7". Colours present: mostly black, some red, some yellow.
H1 1	Crow's nest(?)	1	Potentially a crow's nest cage made from bent metal bars. Roughly circular shaped cage comprised of two white painted thin metal rings joined together in 6 places by thin metal bars. Uncertain function, but perhaps a crow's nest for a ship.
H1 2	Pallet of ropes, rope ladder, and gill netting	3	Pallet containing green, dirty gill netting tied onto white coiled rope of thin gauge; on white rope are threaded black painted wooden football-shaped floats. Length of rather frayed and abraded white coloured coiled rope also present. 2x types of rope ladder, both with pastel blue coloured coiled rope: one with wooden dowels (such as can be seen on display at the Seine Net Loft) for steps (tied in place with white cordage), and the other with planks for steps with holes drilled either side of plank through which rope is ran.

H1 4	Two boxes of fishing floats, gill net, and coiled rope	60	Two large cardboard boxes with cream and orange coloured styrofoam fishing floats; one box contains white coiled cordage, the other box contains a green gill net with a darker green rope on which are attached orange coloured floats. Both boxes contain football-shaped floats with inner ring at either side of float painted blue, gray, or orange. One side of one box, containing white coiled rope, is written "MISS HELEN".
H2 2	Net with fishing floats attached	1	White coloured fishing net with rope and floats attached. Floats are wood and dark in colour, threaded through length wise with white twisted rope which, in turn, is fastened to net by green string. Small lead fishing weights are on opposite end to wooden floats. Ends of rope appear cut.
H2 3	Bags of fishing floats and ropes	3	All floats football-shaped. 1x bag of multi-coloured styrofoam on white braided rope; 2x bags of cream-coloured styrofoam floats on white braided rope and green and white braided rope respectively. 1x group of black painted floats arranged in ring shape. 1x bag of coiled rope, thick gauge; also green and white braided rope, and white coiled rope.
H2 4	5 bags of nets and rope	5	5 bags of nets: 1x white, 1x grayish (likely dirty white), 1x black, 1x greyish black, 1x orangey red nets with cream styrofoam floats at bottom. 1x bag of lead lined braided rope, lead weights slide onto rope (not weaved into it). On piece of tape pasted to side of black net's bag is written "Dolly's personal net".
H2 5	6 wooden rope spools	6	3x spools by Herzog Rope Ltd. of Richmond BC; #s 163, 177, 446 written on them respectively. 1x Samson brand, size #100, with additional text reading "43352 Rivermaster". 1x Scotia Twines Ltd. (Halifax NS), size #100. 1x unlabeled.
H2 6	Bag of canvas sheeting	1	Canvas sheeting, long rectangular pieces. 2 sheets, one with plasticky(?) material on the inside.
H3 1	Pallet of part moulds	25	Pallet of casting moulds, all of wood; complex and circular shapes present. Types represented appear all to be piping, bearings/rings, wheels/roller, transmission housing components (?). Some marked "BDD". One match plate pattern labeled "deck fitting / B.D.D / Guide No1 Indicator" with spindles, plugs, and indicator marked out. One match plate pattern of wingnut-looking pieces. Colours present: mostly black, some yellow, some silver.
H3 2	Pallet of part moulds	25	Pallet of large casting moulds, all of wood; linear shapes present. Types represented appear all to be piping related. "WADENA" appears written in black text on side of one piping (?) corner piece. Colours present: black and unpainted predominate, certain small pieces are unpainted on outside but internal groove is painted red or green; one long piping piece painted green internally. Uncertain company as none are marked, however a stamp on one green painted corner pipe piece is reminiscent to me of W&G, though the colour appears to lean more to CFC.
H3 3	Pallet of part moulds	25	Pallet of large casting moulds, all of wood; circular and ring shapes present. Types represented appear all to be rings/bearings, gears and very large diameter cylinders. One pieces marked "BSHC.44" LONG. X 15" O.D. X 12:2: I.D." One ring has text that appears to read "ANOYS COLLAR". Colours present: mostly black, some red, some yellow, portions marked in silver. Some marked "B.D.D.".
H3 4	Crate of part moulds	25	Pallet of large casting moulds, all of wood; mostly circular and rounded shapes present. Types represented appear mainly to be piping, bearings/rings, wheels/roller, and blades. Some marked "BDD". One piece marked "cast iron / pump line / 1-off". Many have forging instructions on them noting perhaps finishes, ex: "1-off PHOSPOR BRONZE". Colours present: black, yellow, red, and silver.
H3 5	3 stacks of white and silver planks - possibly pen boards	38	Three stacks of wooden planks (38 total), some painted white, some silver, all of different sizes; linear with rounded edges. Possible frass present only on silver planks, it seems.
H4 1	Pallet of part moulds	25	Pallet of casting moulds, all of wood; mainly linear shapes present. Types represented appear all to be uncertain grooved pieces, mounts, perhaps piping, and other uncertain circular/rounded objects. Also present is long board with two wide vertical braces on the back. Colours present: mainly black, two green. For tentative company ID, see research notes.

H4 2	Pallet and cardboard box of part moulds	125	Pallet and cardboard box of large casting moulds, all of wood; circular, rounded, half-circular, linear, and complex shapes present. First box contains roughly half-circular moulds, one side of one piece is written "Brunette MACH. WKS."; colours present in this box generally yellow. Wooden crate on pallet, divided into two sections, contains objects from Burrard Dry Dock: primarily rounded or otherwise complex shapes present; objects appear to be geared items, some transmission body parts; one item labeled "1 off gate valve cover cast iron BDD"; colours present primarily black, some red, some yellow. Second cardboard box mostly contains short linear or small rounded objects; objects appear to be from W&G; named items include '3" valve special 3/4 stem" and '3" storm valve transport ferries"; colours primarily black, some unfinished, few yellow. Third cardboard box contains generally rounded or complex linear shapes; items appear to be rollers, perhaps engine components, and piping; one part of particular interest is labeled "hand winch / aircraft carriers"; colours generally black or unfinished; items appear to be W&G. On pallet at one side are four loose parts: one curved and grooved piece from uncertain company; one match plate pattern of "snaps castings" marked "BDD" with metal fixtures marked "Foundry Service Corp."; another match plate labeled '2" STD BRAZING FLANGE 24-OFF"; and one bearing or ring mould, painted black, on which is written in yellow "2 off cast iron", with an orange rectangle bordered by red, with text also in red reading "drag" (as in cope and drag moulds).
